Development: *slow growth* *quick growth* Foliage habit: *very flat* *very upright* uG = under glass Fl = open field

BARON

- ▶ Baron is our quickest corn salad breeding
- ▶ the variety has broad-round, dark green leaves
- ▶ low soiling, high cutting efficiency and easier processing because of the upright growth



Baron



VISION (NUN 00040 CSC)

- Seeds for trial cultivation. Filed for registration.
- ▶ dark green corn salad with upright growing habit
 - ▶ vigorous, thick-leaved type with a high yielding potential and a large harvesting window
 - ▶ robust against tipburn
 - ▶ ideal for cultivating from spring to autumn in open fields and under cover



Vision

SENSATION

- ▶ compact and uniform breeding with dark green, round-oval leaves
- ▶ stocky, nevertheless upright habit with excellent keeping quality in the field
- ▶ very good shelf life after harvest due to the stable foliage



Granon

CANYON (NUN 00042 CSC)

- Seeds for trial cultivation. Filed for registration.
- ▶ combines compact growth and a large harvesting window
 - ▶ stable and dark green foliage, upright growth
 - ▶ reliable summer cultivation in open fields, insusceptible to tipburn
 - ▶ good vitality and quality, also when temperatures are high
 - ▶ very good shelf life, stable in processing and packaging



Canyon



VIT

- ▶ leaves are veined, dark green and oval
- ▶ yield is higher than comparable varieties, therefore especially suitable for cultivation in greenhouses or poly-tunnels in autumn and winter



Vit

SELEXION

- ▶ very fast, upright growing breeding
- ▶ round-oval, dark green, slightly veined leaves

GRANON

- ▶ particularly robust variety with high yields
- ▶ the leaves are round and thick and have a wide leaf blade up to the beginning of the stem
- ▶ no tendency towards spoon-shaped leaves, even if maturity is exceeded
