

Beans



Broad Beans

MAJOR

- ▶ early, stable yielding variety of type "Witkiem", approx. 18 cm long pods with 4 – 5 seeds, brown-cooking



VROMA

- ▶ particularly early, brown-cooking selection of type "Witkiem", suitable for one-time harvest
- ▶ very uniform, approx. 19 cm long, hanging, thick pods, that allow a high yield with homogeneous fruit set
- ▶ very suitable for the fresh market

Climbing Beans · Round

MATILDA

- ▶ round-podded, very fine variety without strings and with late seed formation, suitable for the fresh market
- ▶ very vigorous growth, high yielding, excellent taste

NECKARKÖNIGIN

- ▶ very good round-podded variety for the fresh market and preserving
- ▶ Neckarkönigin is reliable and well-tried, also under adverse conditions



BLAUHILDE

- ▶ a blue-podded Neckarkönigin with long, round pods which turn green during cooking
- ▶ high yielding and healthy
- ▶ seed colour: beige

NECKARGOLD

- ▶ long, round, deep yellow pods, particularly high yielding
- ▶ reliable variety

Climbing Bean · Flat

HILDA

- ▶ early to medium early, broad-podded bean
- ▶ extremely well suited for the entire open field season
- ▶ variety with high and secure yields, also under adverse conditions
- ▶ long harvest period



Climbing Beans · Oval

EVA

- ▶ variety with a very high early yield
- ▶ very suitable for greenhouse productions as well as for early and late open field cultivations
- ▶ easy to harvest because of the open habit
- ▶ very straight, dark green pods with late development of seeds



TAMARA

- ▶ medium late, very reliable breeding for the entire open field season
- ▶ very robust against rust, therefore especially suitable for late open field cultivation
- ▶ dark foliage, very healthy
- ▶ reliable yields also with unfavourable weather conditions
- ▶ very productive

Dwarf French Beans

SPEEDY

- ▶ earliest selection
- ▶ ideal for sowing under fleece/foil and for early, uncovered open field cultivation as well as for late sowings
- ▶ fresh green, round pods
- ▶ suitable for the fresh market and industry

MAJA

- ▶ benefits of this variety are the very early picking maturity and the very long, round pods
- ▶ high yields

CALIMA

- ▶ early, long-podded filet bean, round, dark green
- ▶ vigorous, upright growth habit
- ▶ homogeneous, fine sorting
- ▶ seed colour: dark brown, marbled

MAXI

- ▶ upright habit with round pods hanging over the foliage
- ▶ the pods, which are held above the leaves (teepee type), can be easily picked
- ▶ Maxi is a very early and high yielding variety
- ▶ seed colour: light beige
