

# Swiss Chard

## BRIGHT LIGHTS

- ▶ long-stemmed Swiss chard, rich in hues
- ▶ most interesting in particular for direct marketers and for plant sales
- ▶ the foliage varies from dark green to green-red
- ▶ the stem colours range from bright red to orange, yellow to white

## WHITE SILVER 2

- ▶ dark green with broad, silver-white veins

# Zucchini



## PARTENON, F<sub>1</sub>



- ▶ parthenocarpic variety for spring cultivation (fertilisation possible without insects), fruits are medium to dark green with a nice and shiny skin
- ▶ in our trials, the early and total yields were convincing, even under stressed conditions

## EIGHT BALL, F<sub>1</sub>

- ▶ round, dark green zucchini which is harvested in the size of a tennis ball (diameter approx. 9 – 10 cm)
- ▶ grows bushy, not climbing
- ▶ 6 – 12 fruits per plant

## ONE BALL, F<sub>1</sub>

- ▶ golden, round zucchini which is harvested when the diameter has reached 7 – 10 cm
- ▶ early variety, does not climb
- ▶ attractive in combination with the green Eight Ball
