

Kohlrabi

NORIKO



- ▶ early, white, open field kohlrabi with many leaves, for early summer, summer and autumn cultivation
- ▶ large and tender bulb with tall stalk

AZUR-STAR



- ▶ earliest blue forcing and open field variety, robust against bolting
- ▶ suitable for heated and cold cultivation under glass, especially for early open field productions
- ▶ slightly flat-round, deep blue, tender bulb with tall stalk

SUPERSCHMELZ

- ▶ white, giant kohlrabi with a long development period, stays tender, even when 3 – 4 kg, planting distance: 50 x 60 cm
