

Small Radishes



Greenhouse · Hybrids

FAMOX, F₁

- ▶ small radish for greenhouse cultivation in the winter
- ▶ cultivation also possible at lower temperatures
- ▶ suitable for marketing as a bunched product

COROX, F₁

- ▶ robust small radish with colour-stable bulbs, round as a ball
- ▶ very uniform and robust against bursting, for greenhouse cultivation in the winter and spring
- ▶ suitable for marketing as a bunched product

GIROX, F₁

IR: Foc 2

- ▶ bright red breed for greenhouse cultivation in the summer as well as for open fields as kiloware
- ▶ suitable for marketing without foliage and for machine harvesting and sorting

LENNOX, F₁

IR: Foc 2

- ▶ intensely red small radish for summer cultivation with a fine root base
- ▶ the dark green foliage is robust and stable
- ▶ suitable for marketing as a bunched product or also without foliage

JANOX, F₁

IR: Foc 2

- ▶ bright red hybrid for cultivation in the summer
- ▶ very even-graded with compact foliage
- ▶ suitable for machine harvesting and bunching due to its high uniformity

Open Field · Hybrids

SOLARIS, F₁

- ▶ robust, reliable hybrid with stable foliage
- ▶ very uniform, round, bright red small radish with fine root
- ▶ for year-round open field production
- ▶ machine washable

ANNABEL, F₁

- ▶ shiny light red coloured small radish for open fields, especially suitable for cultivating in the summer
- ▶ very uniform, stable foliage

ISIS, F₁

- ▶ very uniform small radish for summer cultivation with a shiny red colour
- ▶ the healthy foliage remains compact and easy to bundle, even at high temperatures

Open Field · Open-pollinated

TOPSI



- ▶ fast growing, scarlet, round small radish with fine root
- ▶ suitable for cultivation under glass, as well as for early open field production and protected cultivation under foil

RAXE

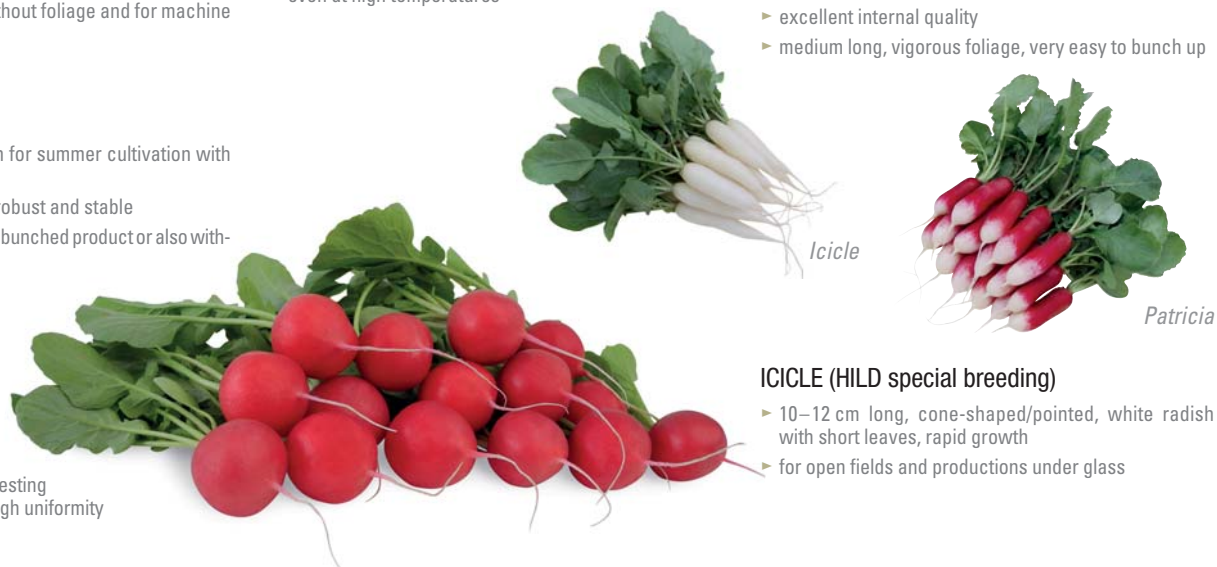


- ▶ round, bright red small radish for open field production with compact foliage, easy to bunch up
- ▶ Raxe is robust against pithiness
- ▶ fine root base
- ▶ for open field production from spring to autumn

PATRICIA



- ▶ medium-long, uniform, cylindrical, bright red radish with white tip
- ▶ excellent internal quality
- ▶ medium long, vigorous foliage, very easy to bunch up



ICICLE (HILD special breeding)

- ▶ 10–12 cm long, cone-shaped/pointed, white radish with short leaves, rapid growth
- ▶ for open fields and productions under glass
